

Youth Daily Living Skills Program

This program includes creating stronger selfadvocates, helping to develop independent living skills, becoming familiar with your community, building job readiness skills, and working to achieve personal goals.

Activities of Programming:

- Volunteering in the community
- Educational courses on: self-advocacy, personal hygiene, setting and achieving goals, job readiness, safety, nutrition, etc.
- Community outings including how to access the community and navigate independently.
- Cooking skills
 Recreational activities such as STEM projects, arts/crafts, exploring your interest
- Help with afterschool homework and projects

Program Detail

- September May, Monday Friday, 3pm – Spm. The Arc will pick-up from schools in Fond du Lac and within a 10 mile radius. Parents/Guardians/Designated adult will need to pick-up at The Arc between 5pm – 5:30pm.
- June August, Monday Friday 8am
 -4pm, participants need to provide own transportation. Participants can be dropped off beginning at 8am, and stay for pickup until 430pm

Guidelines to Participate

- This program is appropriate for youth ages 8-18 years old, who display minimal physical/verbal aggression, are minimal concerns for elopement, can use appropriate self-regulation, can be appropriate in a community setting, demonstrate independent self-help skills (personal cares, feeding, etc..) and show a desire to set goals, and work towards achieving them.
 - Participants must show a desire to participate in all activities and be active members of program.
 - Good attendance is a must.
 - If participants cannot demonstrate these skills they will be discharged from programming

Wisconsin Disability Policy Internship Program

The Wisconsin Disability Policy Internship is a 4-6 month, part-time (20 hours a week) paid internship designed to provide an early public policy career-level experience in disability policy. Interns will earn \$20 an hour and will work within key Wisconsin policy divisions, state agency offices, or disability organizations.

Who can apply?

Required to Apply

- Identify as a person with a developmental disability or a family member of a person with a developmental disability.
- Demonstrated interest in disability advocacy and policy.
- Good communication skills and ability to work as a team and get along with others.
- Basic knowledge or interest in state or local-level advocacy related to disability, long-term care, employment, education, or community organizing.


